Lanham, MD - The National Asphalt Pavement Association (NAPA) announced today that Koch Materials Co. of Wichita, Kan., is the winner of a 2000 Community Involvement Award. The company received its award at a special ceremony at the Association's 46th Annual Convention in Orlando.

NAPA presents its Community Involvement Award to Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) companies that serve their communities through outstanding programs and projects. "NAPA understands how important it is for the companies in our industry to participate in and support their communities," commented R. Wayne Evans, Chairman of the NAPA Board of Directors. "This award reflects the high priority that Koch Materials Co. places upon its relationship with its neighbors."

Koch Materials Co.'s subsidiary, Mesa PDC, and its partner, New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department (NMSHTD), were honored for the program of public information during the widening of State Route 44.
